

ICNC/AOCCN 27 May – 1 June 2012 Guidance for linked Satellite Symposia

Background:

The Australia and New Zealand Child Neurology Society (ANZCNS) is delighted to host the joint congresses of the 12th ICNC and 11th AOCCN in Brisbane in 2012. We hope this congress will benefit paediatric neurosciences across Australia and the region by allowing Australian and regional professionals working in clinical and academic areas of paediatric neurosciences to have the opportunity to meet and interact with a wide array of international experts in the field. Guidance:

- The topic of the symposium should have high relevance to child neurology and related neurosciences, and should not replicate material within the program of the joint congresses. - The scientific committee is available to refer to for early discussion and guidance if you are considering whether the symposium you are planning is suitably aligned to the ICNC/AOCCN, please contact russelld@chw.edu.au if you wish to discuss further
- Whilst ICNC/AOCCN committees are supportive of satellite meetings, the committees do not have funding or resources to become involved in the detail of the organization of satellite symposia, you will need to undertake this entirely independent to the ICNC/AOCCN, including securing speakers, negotiating speaker costs and transport, venue hire and catering arrangements.
- We will, however, be able to help support promotion of your symposium via the joint ICNC/AOCCN meeting

website and also through providing you with contact details for speakers with their consent

Please note that proposals for satellite meetings aligned to ICNC/AOCCN will only be considered before 27 February 2012.
